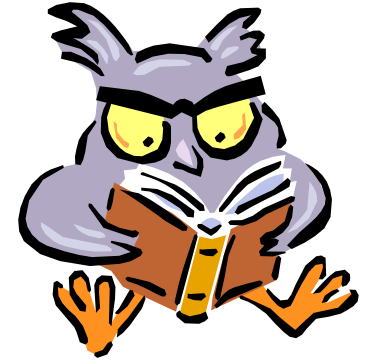


Second Grade Summer Reading List 2008

Wesley does the coolest summer project.

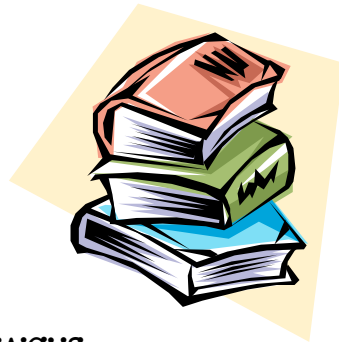
Keller, Laurie. **The Scrambled States of America.**
