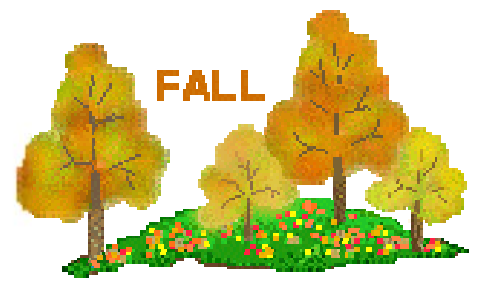

Math:
