2009-10 Academic Year Voucher Program Offer



As a license-exempt educational entity recognized by the Department of Early Education and Care (EEC), the Islamic Academy of New England is pleased to announce its participation in the “Voucher Program”.

What is the Voucher Program?

The Voucher Program, funded by EEC, provides current and former TAFDC (Transitional Aid for Families with Dependent Children) participants and income-eligible parents with financial assistance to pay for child care while they are at work, in school, or on a job training program. For many families, gaining independence from public assistance would not be possible without child care.

What would be the applicable grades?

Parents may opt into this Voucher Program if they have children enrolled in our Pre-School (K1 and K2) and Kindergarten classes in this coming 2009-10 academic year.

How does a parent participate in the Voucher Program?

Current or former TAFDC participants should contact their local DTA office or visit them on-line at www.mass.gov/dta.

For Income-Eligible Vouchers (I-E Vouchers), parents should contact the Massachusetts’ Home Health and Child Care Services, Inc. (HHCC) to be determined if they are eligible to receive subsidized child care. Thereafter, they will meet with a parent-specialist/counselor to complete required paperwork and confirm the applicable reimbursement rate. Family specialists are available to assist parents in providing information on relevant education and quality child care issues.
