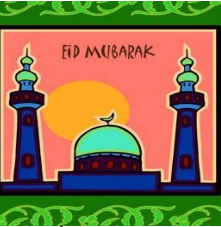

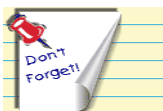
(III) Warmer Clothing, please!
